With its construction beginning in 1840, St Patrick's Cathedral Armagh has a rich 170-year-old heritage. It's therefore not only a significant religious emblem of the city, but a historical one as well, and continues to attract numerous congregational members and visitors alike year on year.

We carried out all mechanical services during the restoration of this Grade A listed building, taking special consideration to reuse old cast iron radiators to maintain the cathedral's ornate appearance. We installed all heating, plumbing, sanitary and ventilation provisions, as well as fully automated BEMS system and public health installation.
